1) Mandarin Language

- **Aims and Features:**

1) *Morning language classes* are designed to build a good foundation of Mandarin Chinese conversational skills.

2) *Afternoon electives* designed to provide different perspectives of Chinese culture including TaiQi Quan, Chinese calligraphy, antique appreciation, sword fighting, Chinese dance, Chinese painting, Chinese cooking and more.

3) *Weekend cultural activities* leading students to experience China's cultural heritage, the Chinese life-style, shopping, places of interest, home visits and many chances to meet new friends abroad.

4) *Immersion programs* encourage students to apply their acquired language skills (speaking, listening, and writing) in real life. To name a few, they will practice how to negotiate in the market with the knowledge learned in their [Mandarin language](#) classes, cook their own Chinese food with what they get from the market, present performances featuring Chinese culture and record their experience in China by writing letters to friends or parents

Arrangement

Language skills training: Besides Chinese language core classes, language training on real conversational situation will be given.

Afternoon electives: Taiji Quan, Chinese cooking, Chinese calligraphy and painting, and Chinese songs.

Weekend cultural activities: Weekend tours for Beijing include the Great Wall, Tian'an Men Square and the Forbidden City, Summer Palace, and Temple of Heaven and Beijing's famous markets and Tienjin City Tour, Tienjin Shopping district, Famous Tienjin residences and temples. In Shanghai visit Pudong, where the new finance and commercial buildings stand, visit Shanghai World Financial Centre, the highest multi purpose skyscraper in China, and the Bund, whereby, old, but grand buildings built in European architectural styles cluster along the bund. Also, visit Nanjing Road, the commercial and shopping street in China, and Yuyuan Garden, Shanghai's ancient gardens with Ming and Qing architectural styles. Students will also visit Xin Tian Di to experience the historical and cultural atmosphere of Shanghai. Other activities include sports games, cooking contest and performances by students at the end of the programme.

Total Fees**US\$1500 to US\$6000**

Everything that the students need during their stay in Beijing/Tienjin/Shanghai is included in the program fees which includes: insurance, airport pickup and drop-off, accommodation, meals per day (breakfast ,lunch and dinner), Chinese classes, afternoon electives, domestic transportation and entrance tickets to different tours and activities.

VISA

When you have enrolled in the program, the visa documents (a Letter of Invitation and JW202 Form) will be sent to you.

Please contact your nearest Chinese Embassy or Consulate for the Visa Application Form and processing fee.

Bring the following documents to the Embassy or Consulate:

1. Visa Application Form (completed)
2. Your valid passport (it must be valid for a minimum of 6 months and for the duration of the program)
3. A copy of "Letter of Invitation" (provided by the university).
4. Copy of the JW202 Visa Form (provided by the university).
5. Relevant visa application fee
6. 2 Passport size photos

For foreign students who applied for short-term courses should apply for F-Visa and X-Visa for foreign students who applied for 1 year/long term courses.
